### Yehliu Scenery & Keelung Night Market

Yehliu is a 1.7 kilometer-long cape that juts into the sea. It's where wave erosion, weathering and the movement of the earth's crust have combined to create weird and wonderful geological oddities, such as mushroom rocks, beehive rocks and tofu rocks. The more spectacular rock formations have been individually named, among them the Queen's head, the Fairy Shoe and the Candlestick.
