

2-Day Tour on Nov 23-24

East coast & Taroko (Marble) George National Park

Taroko National Park is Taiwan's most breathtaking natural area, boasting mountains, valleys, gorges, raging rivers and spectacular waterfalls, Taroko Gorge is a soaring marble chasm cut into the mountain by a fast-flowing, crystal-clear river. The Tunnel of Nine Turns—a man made wonder and part of highway that winds its way through the gorge – is a must see sight, providing spectacular views of the cliffs rising above the river.

The East Coast National Scenic Area, known as “Taiwan's last unspoiled land” stretches 170 kilometers down the east coast of the island. Weathering, erosion, and accumulation have produced a wide range of landforms here. Our tour will stop at Sansientai, Stone steps, Caves of the Eight Immortals.

Sanshiantai consists of a headland facing a small island in the sea. The there huge rocks that stand on the island gave rise to a local legend that three of China's Elight Immortals once landed here. The island was once connected to the headland by a neck of the land that has since been eroded away; it is now connected by a red footbridge. The island is surrounded by coral reefs alive with a multitude of tropical fishes, making this an ideal spot for diving.

Itinerary:

Nov 23--

8:20AM gather at Transasia Airways counter, Terminal 2, Sungshan Domestic Airport Terminal → take Airplane to Hualien → take bus for East Coast (Pachi Scenic, Lookout Stone, Caves of the Eight Immortals, Umbrella → Rueisuei → Huatang valley → Overnight at Hualien

Nov 24--

8:00AM gather at Hotel Lobby → take bus to Taroko National Park (Eternal Spring Shrine, Swallow caves, Tunnels of Nine Turns , Marble Bridge Tienhsiang Lodge → Lunch → Marble Factory → Chi Shing Beach, Stone Sculptural park → Hualien Airport → Arrive in Taipei → the tour end at Domestic Airport, no transfer service to the Academia Sinica or Hotel
